When you first start PodTrapper you'll get a warning about cellular downloading being disabled. Since our device doesn't have WiFi, we'll enable cellular downloads first. Click 'OK' to hide this dialog.

Note: If you *do* have wifi, you don't need to enable cell downloads, if you plan on only downloading over wifi. You can check the 'Don't ask this again' box).

Clicking on a podcast brings us to the episode list. Here we see that Car talk has two episodes available. One is scheduled for download (blue arrows) one is not (gray arrows).

The progress bar shows the download or listened status depending on the state of the episode.

Here you can edit settings for the podcast.

The username and password are available for subscribing to paid podcasts.

Unfinished number to keep refers to how many downloaded episodes podtrapper will keep on the memory card before it starts to auto delete older episodes.

Max to auto-download refers to how many episodes podtrapper will download automatically when new episodes are discovered. Most podcasts only release a single episode at a time, but some release many. This setting controls how many will be downloaded in a single update. (Setting to zero disables auto downloading).

Playback priority is available for defining playlists (see later)

View order determines the order a podcast shows up on the main screen.


"Match duplicates by" allows you to specify that episodes should be deemed 'the same episode' either by URL or by title. (There are very few podcasts that require changing this setting).

Auto add episodes to playlist adds episodes to your playlist after they have downloaded.

Update frequency determines how often this podcast should be checked for updates.

Limitations in what 3rd party apps are capable of on a BlackBerry prevent PodTrapper from ever seeing key presses when PodTrapper isn't in the foreground. This screen allows you to keep PodTrapper in the foreground without having to worry about errant keypresses.

To close this screen, either press the '1', '2', '3' buttons in numerical order (for touchscreen devices), or type '12' on your keypad.

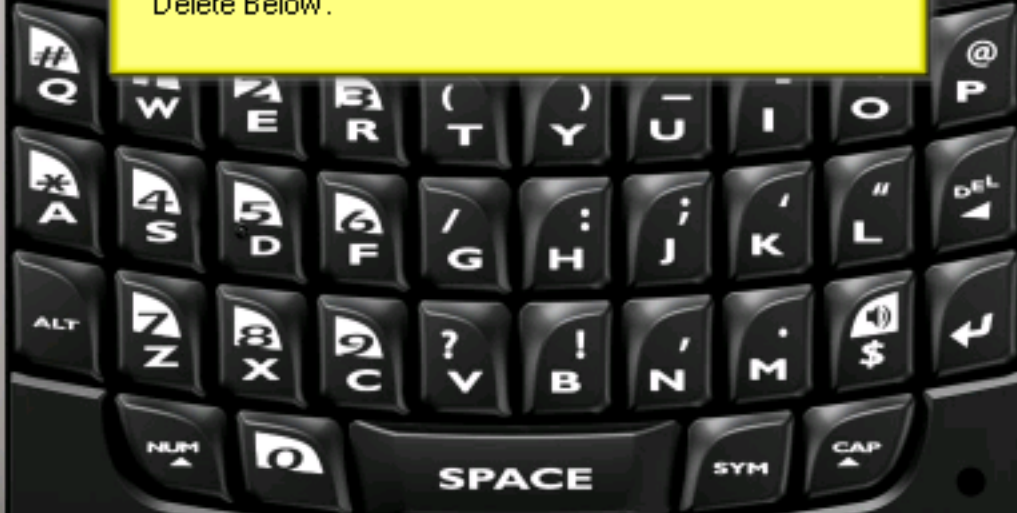

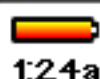

Here are the various episode attributes that can be sorted on when adding episodes.

Episode order refers to the episodes position within the podcast itself. The newest episode is always 1. This allows you to sort newest episodes first across podcasts regardless of their publish date.

Episode order w/deleted is the same, except that deleted episodes are also counted when determining position.

The same limitations that prevent PodTrapper from seeing any keys when it doesn't have the foreground prevents it from seeing the mute key for pausing as well. The second icon installed with PodTrapper will play or pause the current item in PodTrapper.

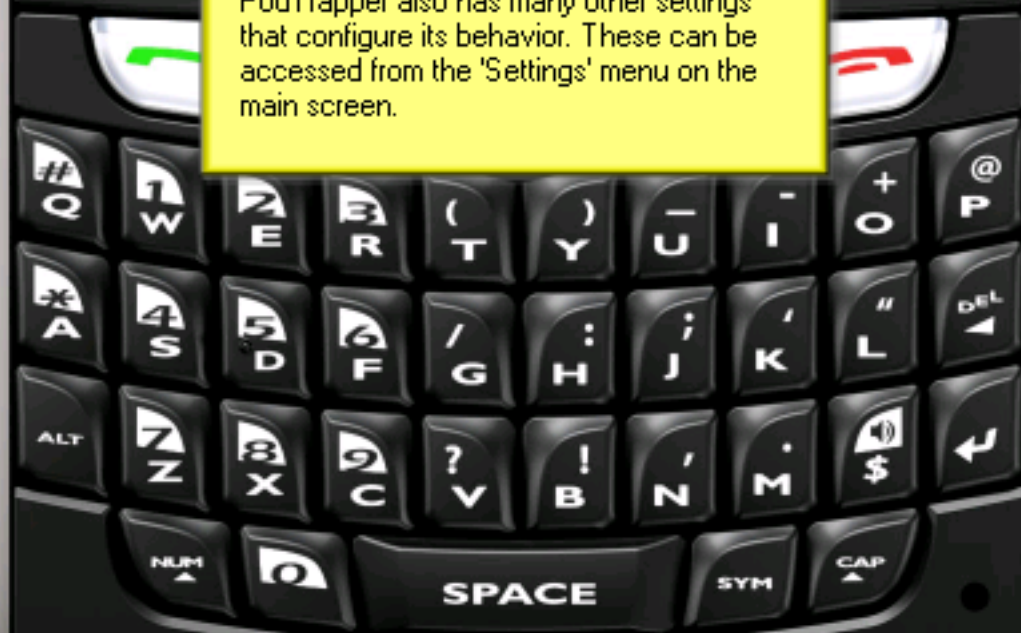

Show files in Media Player: By default PodTrapper attempts to hide its downloads from the media player so you don't end up getting a 45 minute podcast in your shuffled music playlist. This setting controls that behavior. Note that many podcasters don't provide useful categorization data, so how these show up in the media player varies.

Delete episodes after listened: When finished listening to an episode, PodTrapper will automatically delete it to conserve space.

Disable thumbnails: Thumbnails consume about 5-10 times the amount of memory as the entire rest of the application. If you're having hourglass issues it's recommended to disable them.

Auto sort playlist: When items are added to the playlist the playlist is resorted based on the last sort settings.

Double clicking on the desktop downloader icon in your system tray will bring up this screen. The only thing you should ever need to do in this screen, is if you want you can enable it to run on startup.

Once this is running, any time your BlackBerry is connected to your PC and PodTrapper is running, PodTrapper can use your PC to download episodes.


Note: For the desktop downloader to work properly, your BlackBerry must *not* be configured for Mass Storage Mode.

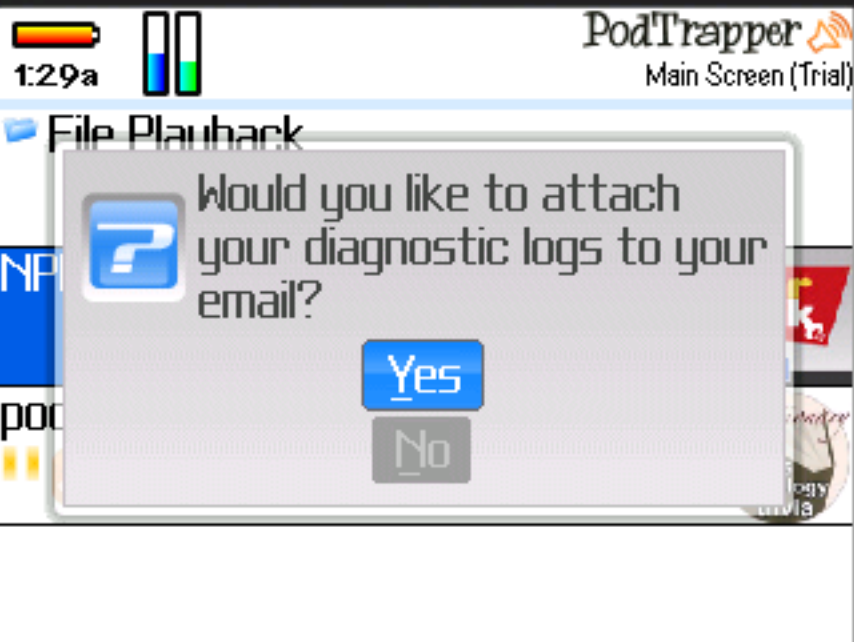

When emailing the developer, you can attach logs from PodTrapper to help in troubleshooting. This is most helpful soon after you've experienced a technical issue, and before exiting PodTrapper (the logs are lost when PodTrapper exits).
